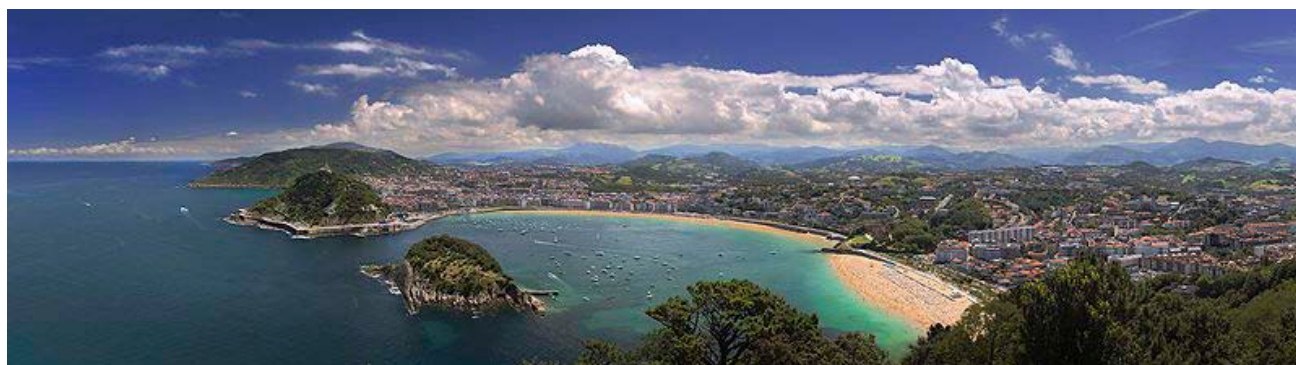

38 SAN SEBASTIAN INTERNATIONAL SWIM MEET.



This year, we celebrate the **38th. edition of the San Sebastian international meeting (Gran Premio Diputación - Gobierno Vasco)**. The swim meet is included in the LEN calendar.

This edition takes place in the city of **San Sebastian**, a beautiful coast-al city in the Basque Country (Spain) on **tuesday, 29th of December, 2020**. The swimming pool is **50 m. long with 8 lanes** and a 25 meter pool for warm ups and warm downs.

The organisation will offer **financial aids** for the **best international swimmers** and will help arranging accommodation near the pool and transportation from and to any of the two main airports, Bilbao (BIO) and San Sebastian (EAS)s

1. COVID MEASURES

Due to the COVID-19 virus the swim meet is subjected to strict measures to ensure the health of all competitors, officials, coaches and volunteers. Specific details about this competition are being developed. The use of a face-mask is mandatory for athletes, coaches, officials and volunteers.

If the Basque government changes its regulations, the schedule and regulations of this tournament can be changed as well. Please stay informed of the most actual regulations via the website natacioneaso.com

2. TIME STANDARDS & EVENTS

Women heats will start followed by men's heats for each event. Prelims will start at 10h and finals at 18h30. There will be a 1h30 hour warm-up period before of each season.

2.1 QUALIFICATION

The meet is set to accommodate 150 athletes, according to the FINA points table. Based on received entries the Basque Swimming Federation will publish the list of competitors.

Qualifying times must be in a officially approved competition between October 1, 2018 and December 10, 2020. It is mandatory times can be verified either via www.swimrankings.net or provided result-files/websites.

3. COMPETITION

3.1 Heats & Seeding

- All events will be swum in the open category of women and men.
- Heats will be swum in 8 lanes.

3.2 Final seeding & reserves

- All distances have an A final.
- The eight fastest swimmers from the heats will qualify for the A-finals.
- For each final two reserves will be appointed.
- An athlete that does not want to be lined up as reserve swimmer must withdraw.
- The scratch deadline for all events shall be 30 minutes, after publishing the results of the corresponding event.

3.3 Call room & dopping.

Call room

Each participant should report to the call room, at least 10 minutes prior to his start. The last call room can only be used by athletes who are expected here.

Doping

The international doping rules (FINA) are applicable. Upon request swimmers must cooperate with representatives of the Spanish official doping authority and be available for testing.

3.4 Acreditations

- On the day of the competition, credentials can be picked up at the entrance to the swimming pool.
- Presenting the deck pass, the team leader can pick up one new starting list every session.
- The number of deck passes per club is determined as follows:

1 to 8 participants 1 deck pass
9 to 16 participants 2 deck passes

- Due to COVID-19 regulations, it is not possible to order additional deck passes.
- Participants and deck passes are strictly personal.
- Teams with 1 to 5 Para swimmers can request 1 extra (free) deck pass.

3.5 Tickets

Due to COVID-19 regulations, tickets will not be sold and there will be no public.

3.6 Event hotel & transport

Please contact the organisation for hotel accommodation and transportation.
The organisation can help cover the expenses for some of the teams and swimmers.

4. ENTRIES & WITHDRWAL

4.1 Entries

- Final entry deadline is Wednesday, December 16, 2020; 12.00hrs (CET)

4.2 Starting List

- After publishing the provisional entry lists, corrections can be sent within 48 hours to easo@natacioneaso.com.

4.3. Entry fees

The entry fee for each event is 3€. Entry fees will not be refunded after withdrawal. Each swimming team receives an invoice.

4.4 Withdrawals

Withdrawals can be done until 24hrs before the first event via easo@natacioneaso.com where all competition days are considered as part of

5. FINAL PROVISIONS

- The organisation reserves full authority to cancel, postpone or change the competition conditions and/or regulations due to reasons beyond its reasonable control.
- Additional COVID-19 regulations will be published.

6. Venue

The swimming pool, Paco Yoldi, is a new 8-lane pool in the heart of the Basque Country. The competition pool is 50m, 8 lanes, equipped with electronic timing (Omega). The venue has another pool that can be used for warm up.
